



## HELL'S LOOP 311-MILE X-TREME ENDURANCE RALLY PROTOCOL

1. **You MUST Carry and maintain an official *authenticated* MSILSF Competition License.** This consists of a duly issued MSILSF 2011 Competition License stamped with the MSILSF 2011 Authentication Stamp. You are responsible for removing your Competition License from the plastic protector in order to receive a check-point stamp.



2. The rally will begin from the Budget Inn, or the Wills Fargo Motel, Baker, CA. The start will be announced via e-mail at least a week before the event. Prior to departing you must obtain a MSILSF **Starter Stamp** on your Competition License.



3. **You must deposit the pre-stamped/pre-addressed *authenticated MSILSF Postcard issued to you with your name and Rider Number* in the United States Mail, Death Valley, CA.**

4. **You must purchase gasoline from Chevron, State Highway #190, Death Valley, CA , obtain a legible/dated paper receipt for gasoline purchase, and submit said receipt to the MSILSF Customs Agent at the conclusion of the rally.**

5. This rally ends precisely when you cross the finish line at Motel 6, Barstow, CA, at which time you must obtain the MSILSF **Finisher Stamp** on your Competition License from the MSILSF Customs Agent, who will affix her/his signature, together with the time.





6. The rider in each displacement class who finished first, having completed at least 305 miles based on starting and finishing odometer readings, will be declared the 1<sup>st</sup> Place Winner for said class, and receive a trophy. Standings for 2<sup>nd</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup> and beyond will be recorded in the official MSILSF records.

7. The map illustrates the highways and roads discussed above. The purple line represents the counter-clockwise route from Baker to Barstow, CA. The approximate distance is 311 miles.



8. Rider's must complete the rally route counter-clockwise from Baker, CA to Barstow, CA, adhering to the rally course. Deviation from the aforementioned highways and roads will result in disqualification. The route is as follows:

Baker to Shoshone via Hwy. #127:	56 miles
Shoshone to Death Valley via Hwy. #186	57 miles
Death Valley to Trona via Hwy. #190 and Paramint Valley Rd.	98 miles
Trona to Red Mountain, CA via Hwy. #178 (Trona Rd.) and I-395	36 miles
Red Mountain to Barstow via I-395 and I-58	61 miles



9. Vehicle Code violation citations issued by the California Highway Patrol or the San Bernardino County Sheriff must be reported to the MSILSF Customs Agent immediately at the close of the rally. A citation for a moving violation, such as speeding/unsafe speed, unsafe passing, DUI or reckless driving, may subject the rider to disqualification.
